## Environmental Health

The Morrow County Health District's Sewage program helps To ensure that residents of the community do not experience disease, adverse health effects or nuisances resulting from improperly or inadequately treated sewage.

### Services Provided

- Issuance of new, replacement and alteration permits for home sewage disposal systems (HSDS)
- Evaluations of vacant properties to determine their ability to be served by a home sewage disposal system
- Inspection/evaluations of existing home sewage disposal systems
- Aeration Inspection
- Non-Mechanical Inspection
- Home sewage disposal system installer, septic tank pumper and aeration contractor registrations
- Issuance of sewer connection orders

### Are You Prepared?

**1. Create a plan for you, your family, and your business.**

**2. Prepare a kit for home, car, and work.**

The following items should be part of your emergency kit and should be kept in a container that could be easily carried if you need to leave home:
